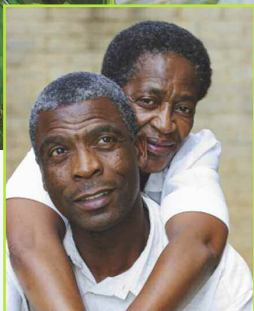
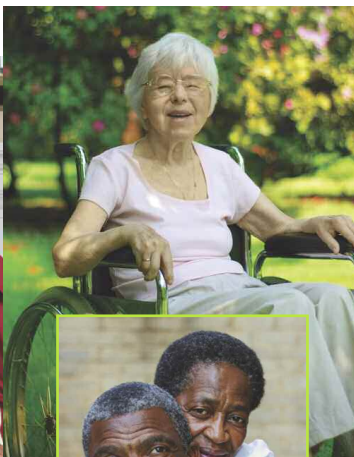

Community Living Services, Inc. (CLS) is a non-profit organization that promotes health and well-being for older adults and adults with physical disabilities by providing community based, in home support services. CLS offers services in Wayne, Oakland, Macomb and Washtenaw counties.

CLS possesses a strong commitment to support people to:

- achieve optimum health and independence
- maintain and strengthen relationships
- be active and contributing members of their communities

We firmly believe that people, with the appropriate supports, can maintain their health and safety while living at home and remain connected to their community.

Our services are an alternative to moving into adult foster care and nursing homes. We promote flexibility of services and funding, and fully embrace a “Whatever It Takes” approach.

CLS is committed to keeping the people we support, and their needs, the primary focus of everything we do. Our business operations and service provision are guided by the Principles of Self-Determination.





AVAILABLE IN-HOME SERVICES

Personal Care Services: Assistance with bathing, grooming, dressing, bathroom needs, transferring, eating and walking as needed.

Homemaker Services: Routine tasks such as laundry, ironing, meal preparation, shopping and light housekeeping tasks.

Home Health Aide Services: Health-oriented services prescribed by a physician such as: exercise regimens, medication and or special diets, changing non-sterile dressing, taking blood pressure and other healthcare activities.

Checking on the Homebound Adult: Regular contact through phone and/or in-home visits to assure well-being and provide companionship and social interaction.

In-Home Respite Care: Assistance with activities of daily living to individuals in the absence of a primary care giver.

Home Delivered Meals: For adults that are homebound, providing at least one nutritional meal per day.

Home Maintenance: Assistance with maintaining and repairing household items on a non-continuous basis.

MI Choice Waiver: Medicaid covered services like those provided within a nursing home but are offered within the individual's home (enrollment in MI Choice Waiver Program required).



AGENCY WITH CHOICE

CLS contracts with The Area Agency on Aging1B, The Senior Alliance, and The Information Center, Inc. to provide services to older adults and adults with disabilities living in Wayne, Oakland, Macomb and Washtenaw counties.

CLS has a network of qualified and experienced support service agencies to offer a full array of in-home services designed to assist adults in living a life of freedom and independence.

You will select, interview and hire the support service agency that best suits your needs.



PARKSIDE PIONEERS
