Both organizations have been helping seniors and people with disabilities for more than 25 years. The Parkside Pioneers program offers recreation classes, day trips and many other activities for the active senior.

“We just moved into a great new location in Taylor which is completely accessible and can accommodate a lot of different activities for everyone all day long,” said Norman. “We believe this program also offers a safe and nurturing environment and that not only helps the senior get out of the house and meet new people, it also gives caregivers an opportunity to relax and do something for themselves.”

The management and staff at Parkside Pioneers are very experienced with seniors and with working with people with disabilities. The program also provides skilled care for all of a person’s daily needs, even the most personal.

Parkside Pioneers is a **FREE** program funded by The Senior Alliance, a nonprofit agency designated as the Area Agency on Aging (AAA 1-C) for western and southern Wayne County. Funding for agency services are provided primarily by the Michigan Office of Services to the Aging and the Michigan Department of Community Health.
